

FactSheet: Using Teams for Trial Monitoring

Who does this apply to?

All research which requires an external monitor to conduct a monitoring visit via teams.

Exception

Trials using Florence eBinders should use the Monitor Review Module to conduct remote monitoring.

What do I need to do before setting up remote monitoring?

- o Ensure the ☐ appropriate agreements are in place with external monitors. Please consult with ☐ MCRI Legal if you are unsure.
- Review any previous Monitor Reports to ensure any action items are followed up
- Schedule a timeframe during which the Monitor will have access to records.
- o Ensure all monitoring takes place as per the trial's □⁷Clinical Monitoring Plan this may need to be updated if remote monitoring has not been included.
- If necessary, ensure hard copy Essential
 Documents are scanned, verified, and redacted
 if they contain patient data.

MCRI IT have approved Teams to be used for clinical research "Remote Monitoring" where on-site monitoring is not possible.

Researchers should therefore conduct and document remote monitoring via Teams to the same standard as traditional monitoring.

Teams Tips

Video Monitoring

- MCRI staff may hold hard copy documents, and especially those with a wet-ink signature, to the camera for an external monitor
- o MCRI staff may **share** their screen to permit an external monitor to view the document for longer

Send / Transfer Data via Teams

- o Ensure that MCRI IT has whitelisted the web domain of the external organisation for collaboration.

 TView listing of currently available domains.
- o If the domain has not yet been whitelisted, researchers can submit a request to add a new domain to the Whitelist to the ☐7 IT Service Desk.
- Before sharing, ensure that the document
 Read / write permissions are updated to your
 preference, from the following options:
 - a) Editable, downloadable
 - b) Editable, not downloadable
 - c) Read only, downloadable; or
 - d) Read only, not downloadable.
- Instructions on how to edit Read / Write permissions.
